Recommended INFANT Immunizations

- 3 doses IPV (Polio vaccine)
- 4 doses DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis vaccine)
- 3-4 doses HIB (Haemophilus Influenza B vaccine)
- 3 doses Hep B (Hepatitis B vaccine)
- 4 doses PCV13 (Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine)
- 1 dose MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella vaccine)
- 1 dose Chicken pox (Varicella zoster vaccine)
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 3 Rotavirus

The above vaccines should be given in the **FIRST TWO YEARS** of life for best protection.
