

Public Health Immunization Clinics

- Regular immunization clinics are held weekly at Public Health on Wednesdays.
- An evening clinic is held on the third Thursday of each month from 4-6:15 p.m. Any child in need of an immunization may come to the clinic.
- Appointments are always best to prevent a wait, but walk-ins are also welcome. Immunizations may be scheduled at other times and on other days by appointment.

**Recommended
INFANT
Immunizations**

- 3 doses – IPV (*Polio vaccine*)
- 4 doses – DTaP (*Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis vaccine*)
- 3-4 doses – HIB (*Haemophilus Influenza B vaccine*)
- 3 doses – Hep B (*Hepatitis B vaccine*)
- 4 doses – PCV13 (*Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine*)
- 1 dose – MMR (*Measles, Mumps, Rubella vaccine*)
- 1 dose – Chicken pox (*Varicella zoster vaccine*)
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 3 Rotavirus

The above vaccines should be given in the **FIRST TWO YEARS** of life for best protection.
